Show: New Works is an annual show of recent work, never before exhibited at Gallery X. Submission is open to all artists. It is held in the main gallery.

Juror: Julia M. Pavone .

Julia M. Pavone is the co-founder and Curator/Director of the Alexey von Schlippe Gallery of Art, at the University of Connecticut's Avery Point Campus. She has held that position for the past 17 years. She has taught courses in Studio Art and Art History at UConn for the past 21 years. Julia has continued her own work as a painter, over the last 35 years, creating large abstract and mixed media paintings and most recently working in the Encaustic medium.

She has been given numerous exhibitions, shown in many art galleries regionally and in New York City, and many commissions, including a mural at the Prudential Center in Boston. Her work can also be seen in various locations throughout UCONN Avery Point's Branford House Mansion.

Julia has been a guest curator at other regional galleries including The Lyme Academy, The Slater Memorial Museum, New London Art Society and Gallery, Three Rivers Community College, and Pfizer Corporation's Art Galleries in both New London and Groton. She has been invited to jury several professional art exhibitions as well as regional student exhibitions in Hartford, Essex, Clinton, Guilford, New Haven, Manchester and Norwich Connecticut, and in Rhode Island.

Julia has continued to expand the AvS Gallery's International Artists Exhibitions through her month long residency as a working artist in Bulgaria in 2003 and 2005. This was awarded by the Griffis Foundation of New London and the Orpheus Foundation of Bulgaria and headed by renowned poet, Lyubomir Levchev. In conjunction with the Griffis Foundation, she continues to act as a cultural representative for their International Artists and Poets Exchange Program between Bulgaria and the United States.

Julia Pavone holds a Bachelor's degree in Fine Arts from Long Island University, and a Master's Degree in Education from Lesley College specializing in Art Education. She has continued her education with post-graduate work at Mass College of Art, and The Lyme Academy of Fine Arts, and Lords Hill Studios.

Venue: Gallery X is a contemporary, cooperative art gallery and performance space in downtown New Bedford Ma. A wide variety of visual and performing arts are presented in the two galleries in the former 1855 First Universalist Church building. The gallery tries to present a mix of established and emerging artists through a wide range of shows both by its members and by outside artists.

Submission details:

Price: \$35 for up to 3 works. \$10/piece for additional pieces. The fee is non refundable and does not guarantee the work will be selected for hanging in the show. Final selection will be made by the juror.

Dates: Work may be submitted between April 29 - May 3, 2009. Work may be shipped to the gallery (with provisions for return shipment if you don't plan to pick it up) or delivered during gallery hours (Wed. - Fri. 11 to 5PM & Sat. & Sun. 11 AM to 3 PM) or by appointment. Work should be ready to hang (properly wired) or display.

Artists will be notified of selection status by 5/8/2009

Show runs from 5/13/2009 to 6/14/2009 with an opening reception on Sat. May 16 from 7 - 10pm
