Show: New Works is an annual show of recent work, never before exhibited at Gallery X. Submission is open to all artists. It is held in the main gallery.

Juror: Christina Lanzl.

Christina Lanzl, is currently the project manager of the Urban Arts Institute at Massachusetts College of Art and Design. She works with clients, communities and artists to create successful places that become part of our history, part of our evolving culture, and part of our collective memory. Committed to excellence in public art and design, her expertise of the arts and culture is complemented by twenty years of experience in working with design teams and professionals in the creative sector. An expert in public art and design project management, community engagement, artistic and sustainable processes, Christina has completed more than fifty projects working with public and private sector clients, cultural institutions and grassroots community initiatives.

Ms. Lanzl also is an artist working in a variety of media. She has recently produced The Conundrum series of small works on embossed aluminum. It consists of drawings of impossible figures. These "metal drawings" feature spaces that can be drawn, but cannot exist in reality. They are a creative continuum that exists in the void between right and wrong, holding the viewer captive, while radiating light and disquieting beauty.

In her paintings, sculptures, and installations, Christina Lanzl explores visual roots while metaphorically addressing the identity and nature of relationships. Negotiating simple shapes on an uncluttered canvas, Lanzl paints with the magic of artistic imagination, alternating mixed media on canvas and paper.

Prior to joining UrbanArts in 2000, Ms. Lanzl was executive director of the Brookline Arts Center and the Bromfield Art Gallery in Boston, and served on the planning team of the Boston Arts Academy. Christina holds a M.A. in art history from Boston University (1991) and received her Diploma in information management and art history from Hochschule der Medien, Stuttgart, Germany (1987). She has presented on numerous panels and published on placemaking and

public art; she is founder and chair of the Placemaking Network at the Boston Society of Architects. Christina Lanzl has received awards of distinction from Massachusetts College of Art and Design, National Accolade Competition, The Nan Foundation, Brookline Arts Center, Manhattan Arts and Artprint Magazine.

Venue: Gallery X is a contemporary, cooperative art gallery and performance space in downtown New Bedford Ma. A wide variety of visual and performing arts are presented in the two galleries in the former 1855 First Universalist Church building. The gallery tries to present a mix of established and emerging artists through a wide range of shows both by its members and by outside artists.

### **Submission details:**

Price: \$35 for up to 3 works. \$15/piece for single or additional pieces. The fee is non refundable and does not guarantee the work will be selected for hanging in the show. Final selection will be made by the juror.

Dates: Work may be submitted between April 7 - 11, 2010. Work may be shipped to the gallery (with provisions for return shipment if you don't plan to pick it up) or delivered during gallery hours (Wed. - Fri. 11 to 5PM & Sat. & Sun. 11 AM to 3 PM) or by appointment. Work should be ready to hang (properly wired, no saw teeth) or display.

Artists will be notified of selection status by 4/13/2010

Show runs from 4/14/2010 to 5/15/2010 with an opening reception on Sat. April 17 from 7 - 10pm
